## **BOCAWINA ZIPLINE ADVENTURE - HALF DAY**

A short drive to the lowland broadleaf forests in the saw-toothed Maya mountains and the Mayflower Bocawina National Park for adventure on Belize's longest zipline! Glide like a bird through the pristine Rain Forest Canopy on the longest zip line in Belize and Central America, with 12 platforms, 8 different runs and a rappel. The complete course is 2.5 miles long with the longest single run being 2,300 feet. Zip line has triple safety and tour takes approximately 1 hour and 30 minutes to complete.

The idyllic island of South Water Caye - 15 acres in size, is one of the few islands off Belize that sit right atop the barrier reef. Our island resort is located on 3.5 acres on the southern end of the island where you step off our beach into the waters of Belize's largest marine protected area - South Water Caye Marine Reserve, and snorkel amongst coral and brightly colored fish.

## **ACCOMMODATION & MEALS**

Welcome to open air dining on the deck of the Pelican's Pouch where Coffee, tea, juice and water is available all day along with a mid-morning snack of fresh baked cookies.

Meals include tropical fruits, salads, fresh seafood and delicious local dishes and desserts.

Island blends and mixes, local beer, rum and wine can be found at our fully stocked bar.

Your island accommodation choices include: cottages nestled in the coconut trees, rooms in the main lodge with a bird's eye view of the reef crest, or cozy rooms in the group residence.

## **COTTAGES:**

With names like **Heron's Hideaway**, **Egret's Escape** and **Sandpiper Suite** each is unique whether by its location –nestled amongst the trees over the water, facing the spectacular sunset; or in its construction - a star gazing platform; singles and duplexes. There are outlets in the rooms and there is a charging station for batteries and small appliances in the main lodge however blow dryers and larger appliances are not supported.
